In 1984, Peter MacDonald decided to work for and buy the family car dealership, D. Alex MacDonald Ford, in his hometown of Summerside. In 2006, he purchased the Ford dealerships in Charlottetown and Montague and later opened Summerside Hyundai with his brother.

In addition, he is one of the original shareholders of the Quebec Major Jr League hockey franchise in Charlottetown, and a partner in Island Capital Partners, which is a Venture Capital Fund supporting PEI start-ups.

Peter has also shown involvement and leadership within his community and business community serving as Chair and past Vice-Chair of the Canadian Automobile Dealers Association, Past President of the Prince Edward Island Automobile Dealers Association, Past President of the Greater Summerside Chamber of Commerce, and Past President of the Ford Dealer Roundtable Association of Canada, Board Director of Queen Elizabeth Hospital foundation, the PEI Canadian Forces Liaison Council, and Director of the Worker's Compensation Board of PEI.

Peter is an accomplished and decorated curler who has represented the Island five times at the Brier and many other national competitions. He has won many provincial titles and has served in numerous roles for the PEI Curling Association. In 2018, Peter was inducted into the PEI Sports Hall of Fame for his countless hours and continued commitment to the PEI curling community.
